	<b>NATIVE PLANT NAME</b>	<b>HEIGHT</b>	<b>UNIQUE QUALITY</b>
<b>1</b>	Red Buckeye ( <i>Aesculus pavia</i> )	10'	red flowers attract hummingbirds
<b>2</b>	Serviceberry ( <i>Amelanchier arborea</i> )	10-15'	white flowers before trees leaf out
<b>3</b>	Pawpaw ( <i>Asimina triloba</i> )	20-30'	attracts zebra swallowtail butterflies
<b>4</b>	Hornbeam ( <i>Carpinus caroliniana</i> )	10-15'	horizontal branches
<b>5</b>	Redbud ( <i>Cercis canadensis</i> )	15-20'	pink flowers in spring
<b>6</b>	Fringetree ( <i>Chionanthus virginicus</i> )	10-15'	fragrant white flowers in spring
<b>7</b>	Flowering Dogwood ( <i>Cornus florida</i> )	10'	berries in winter
<b>8</b>	Green Hawthorn ( <i>Crataegus viridis</i> )	15-20'	orange berries in autumn
<b>9</b>	Witchazel ( <i>Hamamelis virginiana</i> )	10'	yellow fragrant flowers in autumn
<b>10</b>	Wild Plum ( <i>Prunus americana</i> )	10-15'	attracts many butterflies
