1	American beautyberry (<i>Callicarpa americana</i>)	mound	purple berries autumn
2	Pagoda dogwood (<i>Cornus alternifolia</i>)	upright	blue berries summer, shade
3	Flowering dogwood (<i>Cornus florida</i>)	upright	red berries winter, shade
4	Winterberry (<i>Ilex verticillata</i>)	bush	red berries winter, wet soil
5	Possum haw (<i>Ilex decidua</i>)	upright	red berries winter, clay soil
6	Scarlet elder (<i>Sambucus racemosa</i>)	bush	burgundy berries summer
7	Black haw (<i>Viburnum prunifolium</i>)	upright	blue berries fall
8	Rusty black haw (<i>Viburnum rufidulum</i>)	upright	blue berries fall, shade
9	Nannyberry (<i>Viburnum lentago</i>)	upright	blue berries fall
10	Arrow wood (<i>Viburnum dentatum</i>)	bush	blue berries fall
